



Lighted or Reflective Armband Distribution Log

Florida’s Pedestrian and Bicycle Strategic Safety Plan defines pedestrians and bicyclists as vulnerable road users. Many pedestrian and bicycle crashes resulting in serious or fatal injuries occur at night or during twilight hours. These crashes are overrepresented in lower socioeconomic areas.

The purpose of this distribution program is to provide lighted or reflective armbands to pedestrians and bicyclists who do not have access or the ability to purchase similar items to improve their visibility when walking or biking at night.

This document serves as written assurance that to the best of your ability the lighted or reflective armbands provided to you by the program will be distributed free of charge to traditionally underserved, transportation disadvantaged populations in priority areas identified by the FDOT Safety Office.
